APPLICATION CHECKLIST FOR SCHOLARSHIP

A completed and signed application (Online Form). The application will consist of the following:

- Applicant Information
- Essay
 - You will be asked to submit a short essay (600-word limit) based on your choice of ONE of the three prompts below:
 - 1. Every generation builds on the one before it. Describe a moment when you helped connect two worlds, whether between cultures, generations, or ideas. How did this experience shape your sense of identity and responsibility toward others?
 - 2. Leadership is often quiet. It can look like listening when others argue, standing up when no one else does, or helping someone feel seen. Tell us about a moment when you led in a way that might not have been noticed at first. What impact did it have, and what did you learn about influence and integrity?
 - 3. Think about a time when you gave back to the community. What truth did it reveal about people, society, or yourself? How have those realizations impacted how you move forward as a young adult in today's world?
